Educating our young people remains a focus of Inclusion Connections, serving 226 amazing students from age 13 to 40 in an array of evening classes, camps, and the daytime PawsAbilities training program. This is where students learn how to cook, explore their artistic and theatrical skills, bake treats and learn job readiness skills, form lasting friendships, and prepare for greater independence.

At the end of 2022 we began gearing up for an expansion of our programming which required our Learning Center to grow! We have built out a new Transition Academy in this space which will allow us to provide much-needed classes preparing our young adults for the next step in their lives: **independent living**.




Inclusion Connections is investing in building a supportive community, "BelongKC" where adults with Intellectual & Developmental Disabilities (I/DD) can thrive.
