EDUCATION: providing opportunities to explore creativity, stay active and engaged with peers and the community, school break camps, and Transition Academy prep classes for living independently



EMPLOYMENT: geared to preparing individuals for jobs aligning with skills and interests, providing ongoing support for jobholders including transportation and job coaching, keeping jobs more sustainable



SUPPORTIVE LIVING: with BelongKC, our young adults will finally have a choice of where to live, relieving the burden from aging parents and addressing the housing crisis for individuals with developmental disabilities in our community



PRODUCTS WITH PURPOSE

When you walk into our PawsAbilities store in Olathe, you'll realize we aren't just making dog treats and other pet products. We are far, far more than that! You'll be greeted by students who radiate confidence and pride in their accomplishments. The skills they're learning at PawsAbiliities are preparing them for meaningful, community-based employment. As we match students with employers, we provide ongoing job coaching and transportation to ensure that these jobs are sustainable. Employment is critical to improved health and well-being, and key to successful independent living.

2023 Gala FashionAbility took a huge leap forward, raising \$700,017! The second annual TOP MODEL competition contributed \$155,576 to that amount, with 28 teams competing for TOP MODEL. Meg Dieter and Lauren Thompson raised the most money and were awarded on stage. UnitedHealthcare continued as our Presenting Sponsor, and the event was sold out at 610 attendees.

INDEPENDENT AND SUPPORTIVE LIVING

Housing availability for individuals with developmental disabilities is at a crisis level in our community! Other states such as Colorado and Nebraska have multiple projects in the works, while Kansas has zero. Inclusion Connections is putting the needs of individuals with I/DD at the forefront as more and more individuals are living with caregivers aged 60+, setting up forced placements in the future. We are developing an innovative (first of its kind in Kansas!) campus called BelongKC and have purchased land at 11501 S. Ridgeview in Olathe! The Capital Campaign to fund this project raised a cumulative \$901,333 with fundraising continuing.




TOTAL REVENUES \$1,525,530
